


Since memorable times man has tried to replace his missing dental pieces with different types of the maxila with individual crowns over implants, and where it is possible, and if the bone permits its anterior portion. Nowadays the possibility exists for total reconstruction of the mandible and dealing with one single missing tooth and generally for reconstruction on only upper maxilla and implants. In the past, positioning individual crowns over implants was spoken about only when the same number of implants. (speaking of the ideal bone), make equal the number of roots that were lost and replace them with
